6th Annual LPSC Student Research Symposium Friday, April 23, 2010 Old Main

The Department of Languages, Philosophy, and Speech Communication (LPSC) is pleased to announce its 6th annual Student Research Symposium, which will be held on Friday, 23 April, 2010, in Old Main.

Students who have taken advanced coursework in the department, and who are interested in participating in the symposium, should submit, for consideration by the LPSC Student Research Symposium Committee, an abstract of 150-200 words detailing their proposal on any topic related to their studies in LPSC, by 11 March, 2010. Be sure to include a title.

If the committee accepts the proposal, students will be notified by 26 March, 2010. A copy of the completed presentation must be made available to the committee by 9 April, 2010.

- ❑ Abstract due 11 March, 2010
- ❑ Length of presentation: 15 minutes
- ❑ Non-English submissions welcome
